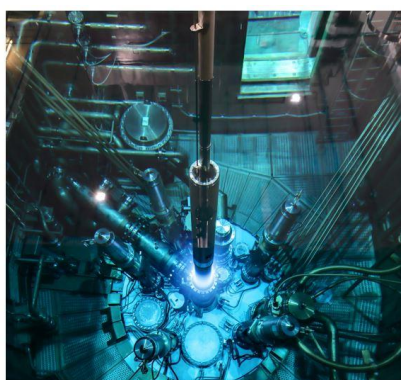
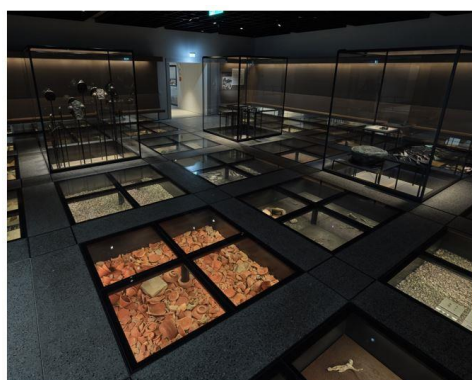

From 19 to 22 May 2026, the Heinz Maier-Leibnitz Zentrum (MLZ) in cooperation with the Bavarian State Archaeological Collection will host the 2026 edition of the **International Conference on Neutrons in Heritage Science**. The event will take place in the state collection itself, located in the heart of Munich.

The conference will highlight the use of **neutrons** in heritage science, but contributions using **other advanced and complementary analysis techniques** are also welcome. It follows an initial conference in Dongguan, China, which took place from 26 to 29 November 2024.

The conference program will offer four intense days packed with **keynote speeches**, contributed **talks**, a **poster session**, as well as optional **tours** through the state collection, an **excursion** and a **conference dinner**.
